APT Privacy Policy

Updated: January 21, 2022

Overview

Members can choose what personal data they wish available to other members. All personal data a member allows to be displayed are considered "public" and may be shared with both other APT members and external parties. What data are displayed publicly and what are not are controlled by the member by entering his profile in aptatlwildapricot.org and selecting the privacy option. What personal data are shown as "public" and what data are not shown are the responsibility of the member.

APT honors the privacy of its members and will never disclose to any individual more information than the member has granted public access (with only the exceptions noted in the next section). Personal information for which a member has granted access is considered public information and may be shared with external parties. When a member registers with APT, the following items are made public: name, preferred email, partner name, and picture. Each member has the capability of restricting (or blocking from public view) his personal information, with the exception of his name. Members can also choose additional items to be made public, e.g., address.

Although members can share other member's public information, APT prohibits any sale of such information, and discourages the distribution of such information for multiple members.

Information that APT Collects from Members

A list of the type of information collected by APT about its members can be seen by visiting your member profile. All information beyond what is public may be used by APT and possibly shared with Board members only for administrative purposes, with the exception of birthdays, anniversary dates, and veteran status (which may be used in APT publications or at meetings in a respectful manner, honoring the individual).

All information obtained regarding credit/debit cards, used for payments for APT memberships and special events, are processed on SQUARE and forwarded to your credit/debit card companies for processing. APT never obtains and therefore never retains any records of your actual credit or debit account numbers.

Giving consent for others

A member who provides information applicable to another member, i.e., partner (bundle) memberships, is obligated to provide correct information and only with the approval of the other member.
